Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for people who are deaf, hard of hearing or disabled by creating mutually beneficial partnerships with specially trained dogs. Lions support is critical to achieving this important mission and this new program is designed to recognize and encourage financial contributions to the organization.

Beginning with gifts made on July 1, 2006, Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota is instituting a program to recognize the generosity and hard work of Lions, Lioness and Leo Clubs throughout Lions Multiple District 5M in supporting our work.

Recognition will occur at each of four levels of club or personal giving as follows:

Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota will recognize cumulative contributions made during a maximum of 60 months for the awards, starting July 1, 2006. This approach creates an opportunity for clubs with limited funds to achieve recognition. Awards for contribution levels below \$500 will be awarded automatically and sent with the Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota thank you letter.

Awards at \$500 or more will not be made automatically. These awards must be requested from Hearing and Service Dogs of Minnesota in writing and must include the exact spelling of the club or individual to be named on the plaque.
