# “WATTS” NEW in 5M9

District Governor— Donald Hendrickx



What a great experience Lion Pat and I had as we just returned from the 96th Lions International Convention in Hamburg, Germany. Over 20,000 Lions representing 130 countries were there, all with the same purpose - to celebrate this organization of Lions. It was an honor to be surrounded by so many dedicated Lions, and listening to Laura Bush was unforgettable. It was also an honor to witness the election of Lion Mike Molenda from District 5M6 as International Director. Congratulations to ID Mike and Lion Linda.

As I reflect back on the convention, a few thoughts come to mind. International President Barry Palmer's theme is "Follow Your Dream". ~ Clarify your Dream ~ Believe in your Dream ~ Act on your Dream ~ Pretty good advice !

He has also challenged each of the 754 District Governors at the convention to start new clubs and to increase membership to 1.4 million Lions by the end of 2014. So I am asking your help in this goal. I challenge each Lion to bring in ONE new member this year and more importantly, retain the members that you already have. If you need ideas on membership and leadership, ask our GLT/GMT team of Lions Bruce Beck and Randy Beaver. They are both eager and willing to help clubs.

Another one of President Barry's goals is to have women represented by 50% in the Lions by the year 2017. For those clubs who don't have women in their club, consider this challenge and invite women to join. They can only make it better ..

Consider following the Leadership Road to Your Dreams at the 37th Annual USA/Canada Lions Leadership Forum in Overland Park, Kansas September 19-21, 2013. Lion Pat and I attended the Forum last year for the first time and were impressed by all the seminars that were offered and the knowledge that we brought back was so worth the trip. There are forms on line at [lionsof5M9.org](http://lionsof5M9.org) and click on Multiple 5M, go down to USA/Canada forum Official Site & click on the link. There will also be forms available at the fall Zone Fairs.

Keep the dates of the upcoming Zone Fairs handy and make sure that you attend in your Zone. I want to see every President and Secretary from every club represented at these meetings along with a good share of your clubs. Here is where you can sign up for the Project Chairs to come out and explain their project to your club. I know that there are some clubs that have no idea what the projects are and this needs to change. How can you get excited about an organization when you don't know what it is even about. Let's change this ! Look for the dates of the Zone Fairs in my calendar under this article.

I already have over half of my District Governor club visits booked, so if you have not requested a visit, I would suggest you do so soon. Hopefully the date you want is still available. Thank you to all those who have booked early.

*Something to ponder : All journeys start with a dream. One dream can make a difference, so follow that dream, discuss your dream, share your dream with your club and make it come true !*







## JUST ASK!

The GMT and GLT encourage all clubs to attend the upcoming training in Bluffton on September 29<sup>th</sup>. It is a fantastic opportunity to learn more on conflict resolution, legal issues, committee chairmanship, membership and the CEP process. The trainers that are lined up are the best! We would like to give an update on how the year ended up with membership totals. This past year 5M9 brought in 210 new members but dropped 298 for a net loss of 88 members. A little over half the clubs lost membership (53%) the rest gained or stayed the same. The GMT working with the GLT will be working very hard so all clubs show a gain in membership this year. It is so important for all the clubs to attend the first round of combined Zone meetings so we can get club visits scheduled. We as a Lions group can accomplish anything we set our sights on; we have seen it time and time again, we have blown our goals away! This year all clubs must set retention and recruiting members as a top priority. One of International President Barry Palmer's goals is to see an increase in female membership. The GMT and GLT will be supporting this goal. The GMT and GLT are there to support, encourage and provide training to the membership of 5M9 so that continued growth can occur in the district. We are very much looking forward in supporting what ever the needs of our district are to increase membership.

We want to give big congratulations to the clubs that increased membership by over 10% this past year. They are Cass Lake, Detroit Lakes, Merrifield, Ottertail and Verndale.

Take a quick drive around your town; do all your Lions projects have the Lions emblem on them? Are the emblems new or faded out? When you come into town is there a Lions emblem on your city population sign? It is so important to keep your Lions emblems on display and looking new. You can usually tell how active a club is just by looking at their signage when you drive through the town. If your club is having a summer celebration, make sure to have a Lions booth to promote your club. There are several Lions handouts that are available. Make your own club brochure with your clubs projects and other information. There is a template on [lionsclubs.org](http://lionsclubs.org) that you can type in your information and print out. If your club does not have a web site please start working on one. There are so many things that we can do to make a difference when we are recruiting members. Remember it all starts by **Asking!**
